- All rules for this Diplomacy variant as in the 1971 rulebook except 1) as modified below.
- The initial set up is optional in types, numbers, and placement of units. ie any desired combination of the appropriate number of Armies and Fleets. These units may be initially placed on any home province (fleets on coasts only of course). Prior to the first move players may negotiate on the initial 1900 placements. The initial builds however are not made known to the other players, nor the provinces in which they are placed.
- The moves are as in the regular game but players must number them. 3)
- . 4) Battles: the only moves that are published are those that result in conflict. That is: Moves that have succeeded though opposed, stand-offs, and failed moves. Illegal or moves are also published. Supports for moves that do not occour are not published. All other moves are not published and are known only to the player making them.

The attacker may also number the possible retreats so that he too is informed of the retreat made. Both attacker and defender are informed by their numbers, of the retreat made. If disbandment is not listed as a numbered alternative then all players will be made aware of it.
  - Builds will be made on home supply centres. Order of priority is decided by player's numbering. A player may decline builds in which case other players will not know how many centres he has. Simple errors will however be reported as number of units short.

Conditional builds may be ordered. These are conditional on orders published. The build only occours if the move gets published. In case of any ambiguity no build will be made.

NMR: If a player missed a move he will be given a published NMR. In case of an NMR on the first move the player may submit builds prior to Autumn 1901. He would also have to submit conditional retreats in case the chose provinces were occupied.

In case of players not submitting removals the GM will make and pullish them.

- Make sure that you number everything and keep a spare copy for yourself, or you may find yourself loosing units.
- GMing mistakes are very unlikely of course, but are also vey difficult to spot, so notify the GM immediately if you think you have a a found one.

So there are the Stab rules and the waiting list is open to any masochist who wants to play. I know that a couple of people out there hav

have asked about it before now so perhaps a game will start fairly quickl quickly now. 

\* The Official Secrets Act

This act supresses a vast amount of news. An Official Secret need not be something that they would like to know, they already do know.
