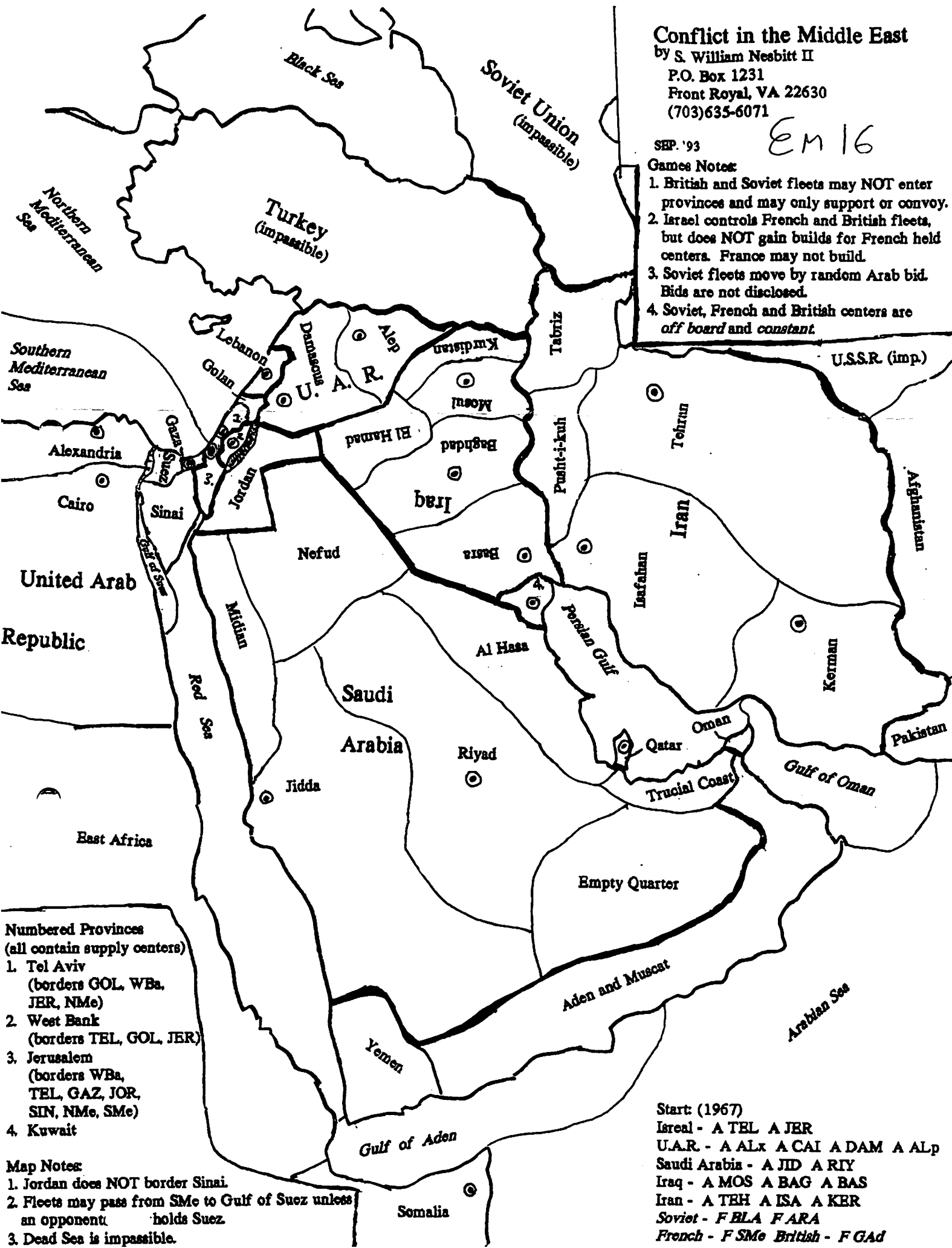

1. British and Soviet fleets may NOT enter provinces and may only support or convoy.
2. Israel controls French and British fleets, but does NOT gain builds for French held centers. France may not build.
3. Soviet fleets move by random Arab bid. Bids are not disclosed.
4. Soviet, French and British centers are off board and constant.

1. Jordan does NOT border Sinai.
 2. Fleets may pass from SMe to Gulf of Suez unless an opponent holds Suez.
 3. Dead Sea is impassible.
