Diplomacy 1701 by Michael George Homeier

Rules: As in standard DIPLOMACY except for: ((1961 RULEBOOK))
X.

1. Fleets may not pass thru Bremen due to lack of a canal.
2. Gamesmaster must be included
3. One move forms one year, beginning with the year 1701
4. Retreats MUST be written
5. You gain a new supply center by having a piece in it at the year's end.
6. You may raise new peices at the end of the move(winter builds) in home supply centers. HOWEVER, only Britian may construct additional fleets-- others are limited to one at any specific time.
7. START POSITIONS: Britain: F Edi, F Lon, A Gla
France: F Tou, A Bre, A Par
Austrian Hapsburgs: F Tri, A Wie, A Bud
Holy Roman Empire: F Ber, A Brem, A Nur
Poland: F Ode, A War, A Pos, A Rig
Ottoman Empire: F Sin, A Ath, A Ist

NOTES: Sweden in 1701 consistedd of both Finland and Sweden(supp Centre).
Denmark in 1701 consisted of both Norway and Denmark
Both Danish provinces(Norwya and Denmark) border on the x large Sweden(Fin&Swe)
Both the Swiss Confederation and the Vassal States of the Russian Empire are impassable and may not be entered.
CORRECTION: Crimea does border on Odessa
Naples borders Adriatic, Ionian and Tyrrhenian Seas, Bosnia borders the former two; K Tunisia borders ONLY the latter two
