DIPLOMACY, VARIANT "1991"

"1991" is a DIPLOMACY variant that takes place in europe in a possible future. It's not like standard DIPLOMACY where you move armies and fleets, in this variant you move counters, that represent different economic organizations and their domination in the particular area. The organizations are EEC, EFTA (both split into north and south parts), CMEA (Comecon) and the two countries Germany and Soviet union. This is what has happened in europe:

- * The Baltic states has worked themselves to liberation from the Soviet.
- * The Armenians has broken with Turkey and Soviet union. Armenia is very poor with a complicated economy, this why they don't receive a supply-center.
- * Germany has been united, again. A new very strong economic power.
- * Great Britain has (at last to some, unfortunately to others) released control of Northern Ireland.
- * Albania has closed their borders completely. This thus that no one have admittance to Albania (impassable).

The players:

1. EFTA, North (yellow). Norway, Sweden and Finland.
2. EFTA, South (green). Portugal, Switzerland and Austria.
3. USSR (white). With three supplycenters.
4. GERMANY (black). With four supplycenters.
5. EEC, North (dark-blue). England, Denmark and Holland.
6. EEC, South (light-blue). France, Italy and Belgium.
7. CMEA (red). Hungary, Bulgaria and Rumania.

EFTA = European Free Trade Association
EEC = European Economic Community
USSR = Union of Soviet Socialist Republics
CMEA = Council for Mutual Economic Aid

In the real world several of these countries are members of more than one organization, but in the game they're not.

The difference in rules are not very big. The changes are a new map and no fleets. No fleets makes the convoj-order to disappear, but instead the counters (armies) can enter all areas (but not impassables) including water areas. The areas on the map are named after the country (in english) if it is a country with a single area or after a major city (in native language) if the country is split into two or more areas.

I hope you like my variant, though it's very simple.
